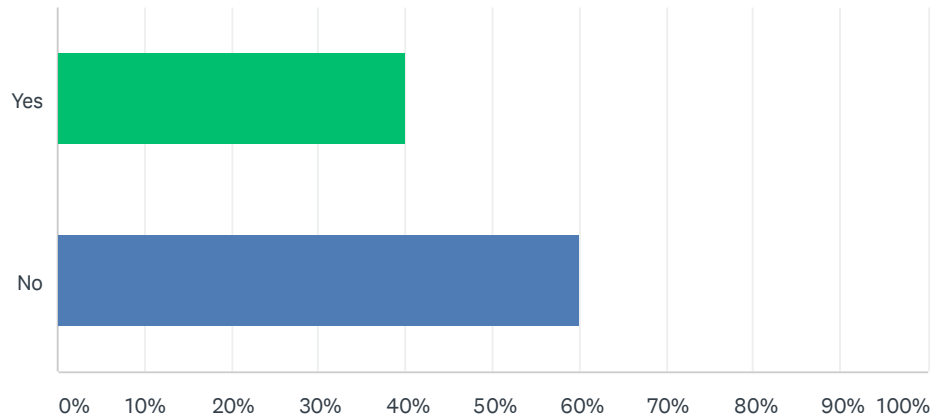


Q1 Should school district employees (administrators, teachers, and support staff) be required to get a COVID vaccination as a condition of their employment

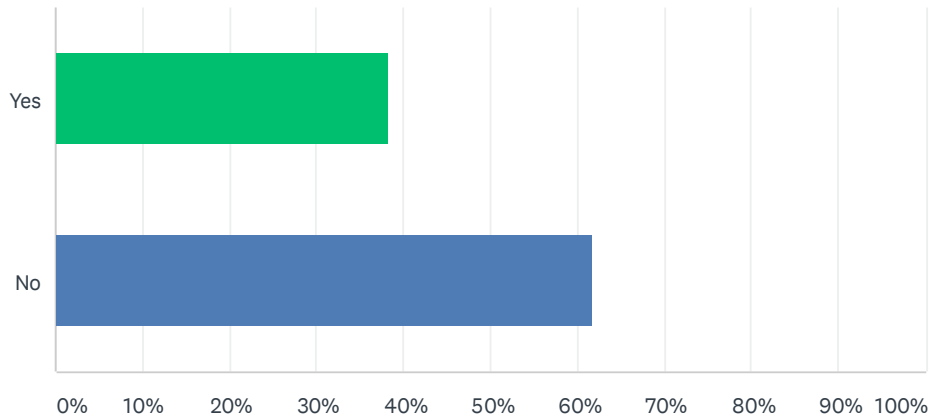

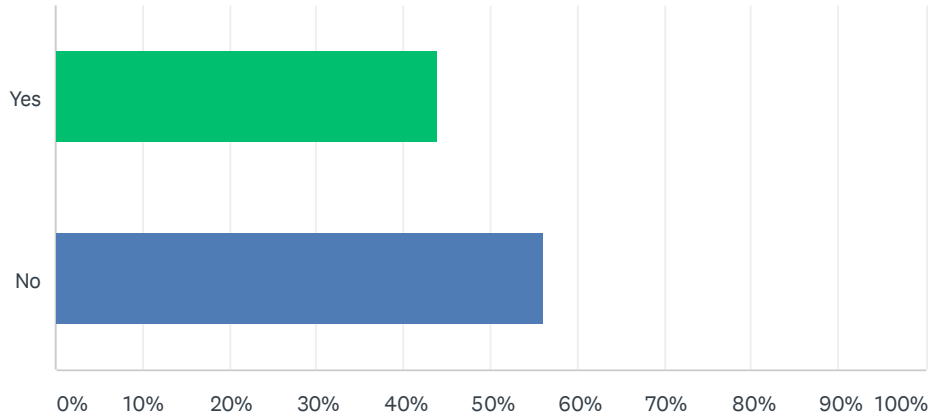

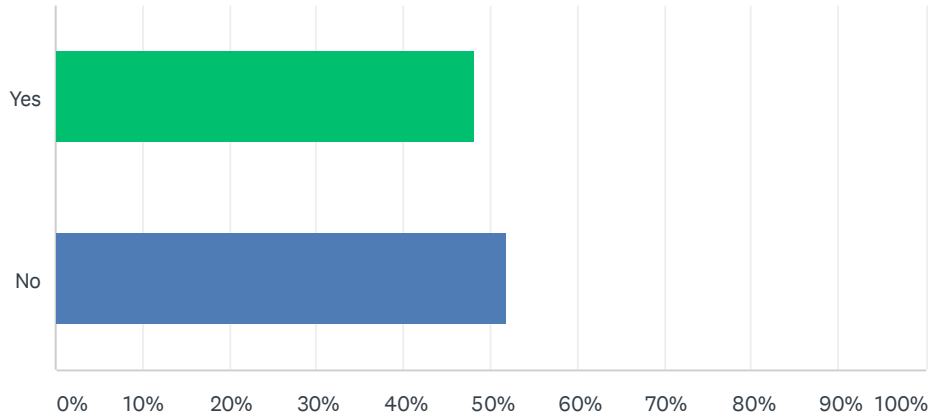

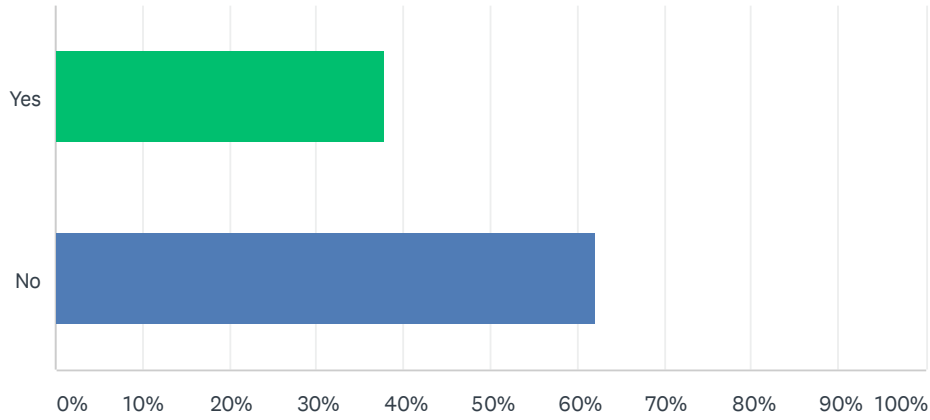

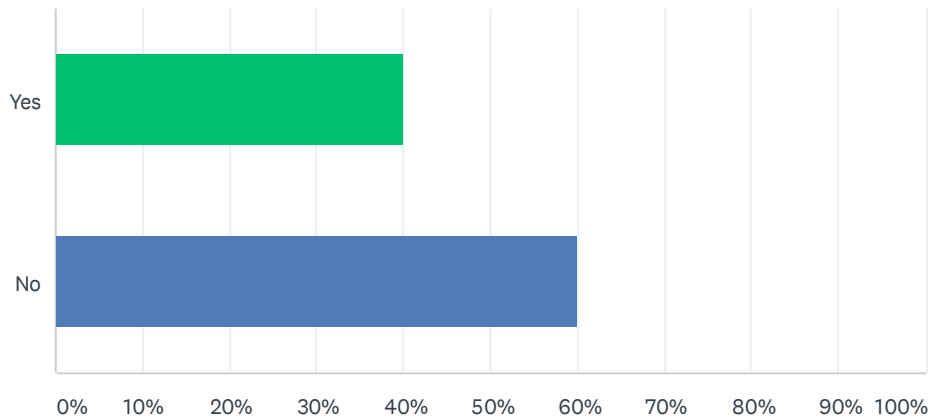

Q6 Should state employees and health care workers be required to get a COVID vaccination as a condition of their employment?

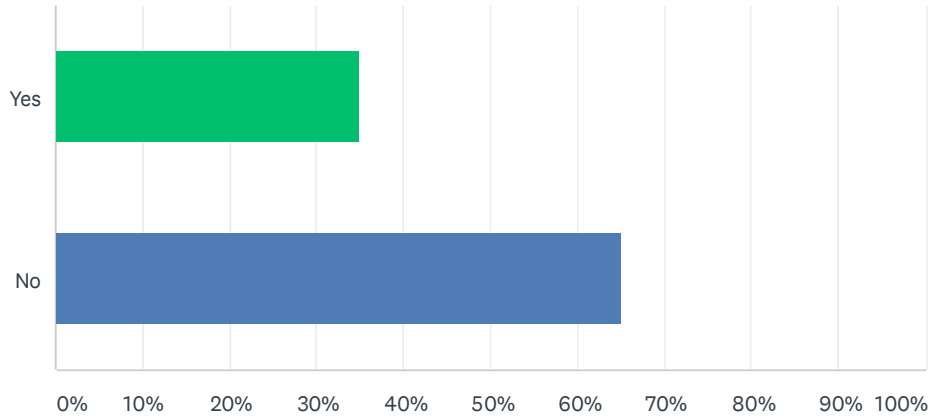

Q7 Is it appropriate for the governor to extend his vaccination mandate to other local government workers besides school districts, such as city, county, and PUD employees?

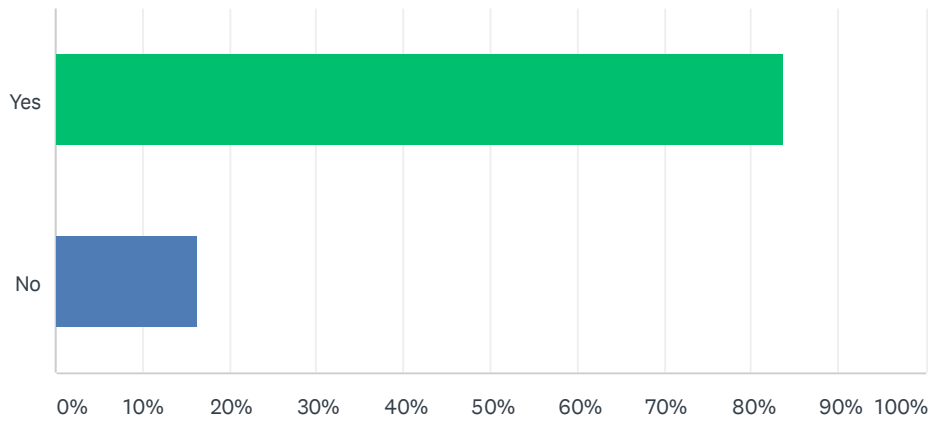

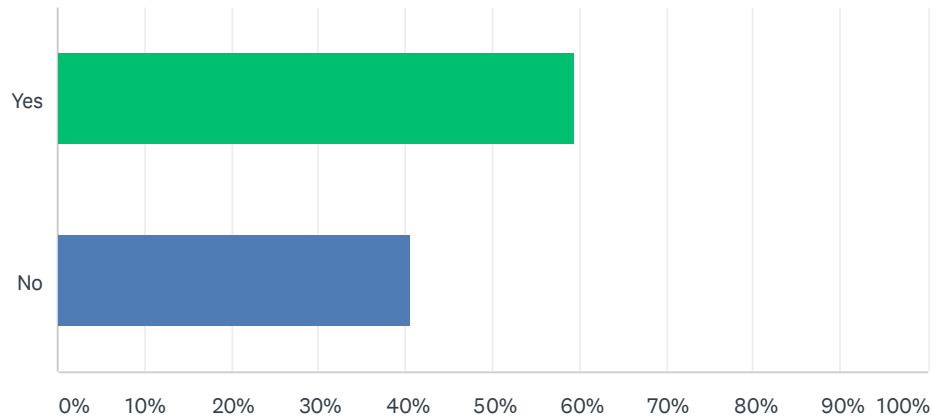

Q9 Should Governor Inslee’s vaccine mandates include a “personal/philosophical” exemption, in addition to “medical” and “religious” exemptions?

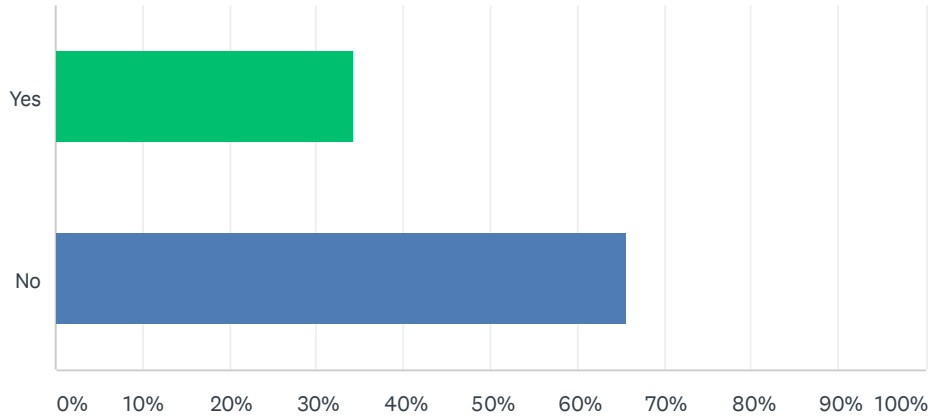

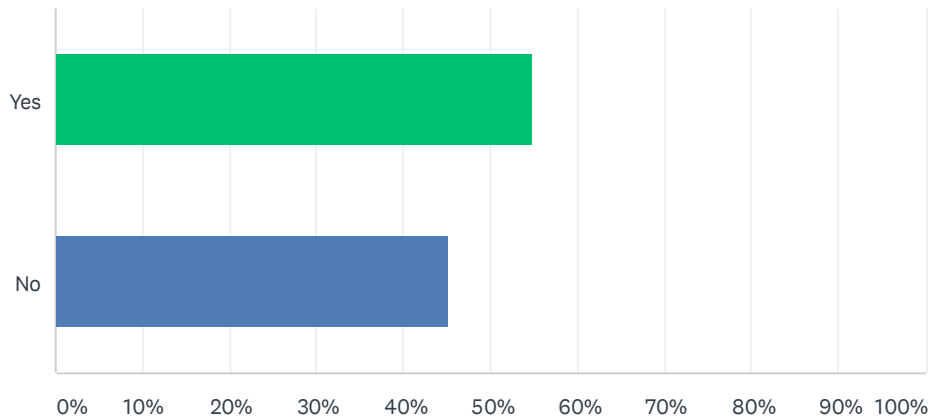

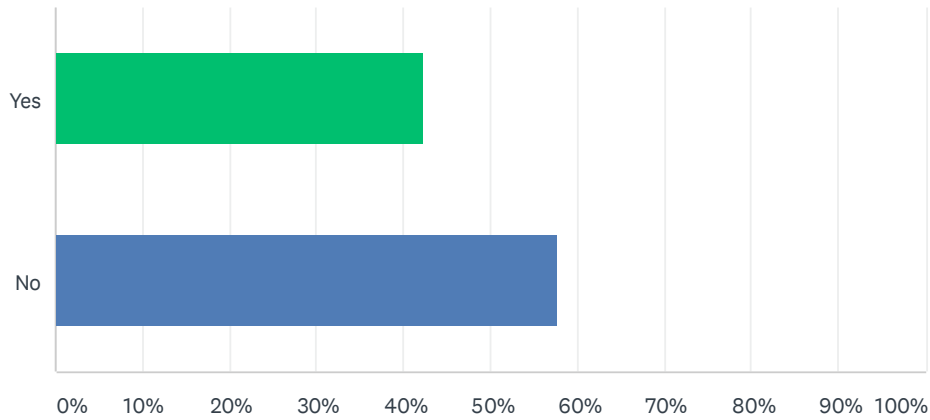

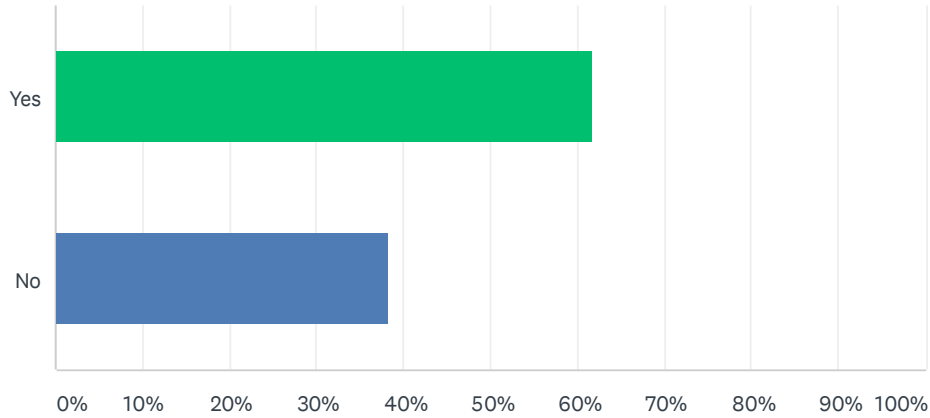
