Subject: Please approve Senate Bill 5001 (Hawkins-Hunt) Public Facilities Districts

Dear Chair Duerr,

Thank you very much for the opportunity to share our support for SB 5001. As stakeholders in Chelan and Douglas counties, we pride ourselves in the ability to work together to meet needs and provide services without our region.

SB 5001 will provide our region with the organizational and financing mechanism to seek voter approval to form a second Public Facilities District for the specific purpose of constructing and operating a regional aquatic center-sports complex. The greater Wenatchee area utilized the Public Facilities District statute in 2011 to avoid a bond default for the Town Toyota Center in Wenatchee. As a result, our region is not authorized to utilize the statute to form for a second PFD without adjustments in law.

As our region continues to thoughtfully consider the possibilities of joining forces to construct and operate a regional aquatic center-sports complex and to potentially seek voter-approval, we need certainty that a sufficient organizational and financial mechanism is available.

We urge you to approve SB 5001 (Hawkins-Hunt) at the next available opportunity.
